## Building a Smoke-Free Policy at Nuevo Amanecer

Nuevo Amanecer was the Farmworker Housing Development Corporation's (FHDC) first affordable housing development in Woodburn, Oregon. In August 2008, Oregon's Latino TPEN surveyed 58 tenants to get their input about creating a smoke-free policy for the soon-to-be remodeled Nuevo Amanecer. This report summarizes the findings from the survey.



### Tobacco Use

- 13% were currently smoking cigarettes
- Only 2% reported that someone had smoked in their home in the last 30 days

### Attitudes toward Smoke-Free Policy

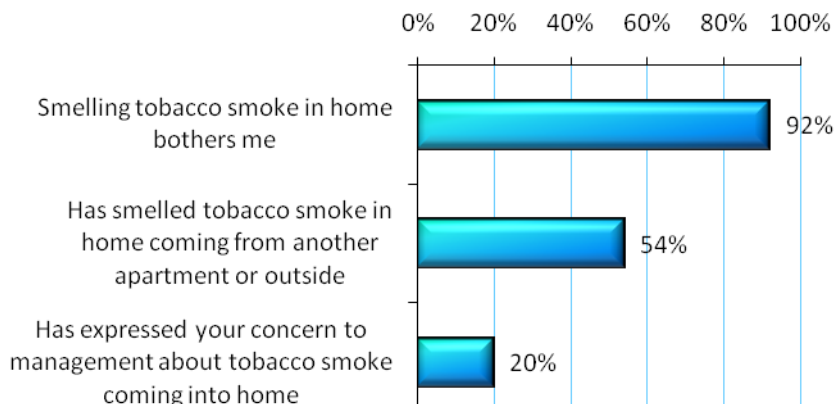
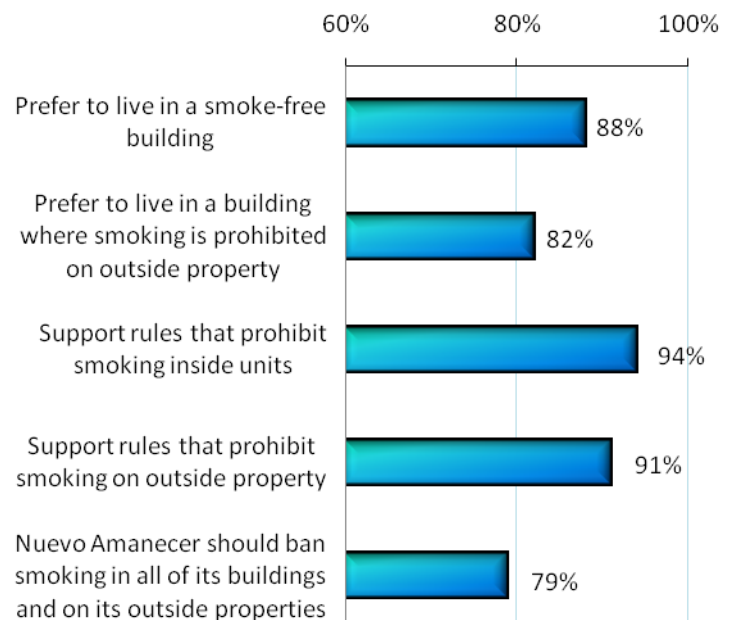
Tenants reported overwhelmingly positive support for smoke-free policies, both inside and outdoors on Nuevo Amanecer property (see graph below).

### Personal Rules about Smoking in the Home

- 94% of tenants had a rule against smoking in their home
- 6% allowed smoking in their home in some places at some times

### Attitudes toward Smoke in the Home

Almost everyone surveyed said that the smell of smoke in their home bothers them, but most will not tell management if smoke is coming into their homes from outside of their apartment (see graph below).



### Conclusion

**Tenants overwhelmingly support smoke-free policies at Nuevo Amanecer.**
